Tasting Notes Dressed in fresh purple red colour, this is a voluptuous Pinot Noir with rich fruit notes of cherry, raspberry, plum and strawberry – a red fruit party! – enhanced by subtle smoked hints. In mouth sweet fruit notes stand out, and its fine tannins give it a great texture and a mouth filling structure. Balanced and New World styled, this is a wine of personality and elegance. Sexy, pure and simple, it's a young and refreshing Pinot.

Soil Alluvial and gravelly. Low in fertility.
Climate Gentle, with cool nights and foggy mornings.
Harvest Mechanical / Hand picked. March, 2009.
