

## OCIO PINOT NOIR 2009

**Vintage** 2009  
**Grape** Pinot Noir 100%  
**Appellation** Casablanca Valley

**Tasting Notes** This iconic wine is an intense, ruby red color. It is complex, yet delicate with aromas of black fruits and flowers that combine beautifully with notes of black cherries, raspberries, and plums. Its palate is laced with intense sweet fruit flavors that are elegant, rich and concentrated. This Pinot Noir has beautifully soft and full tannins and a smooth, lasting finish.

**Soil** Sandy with a bit of clay.  
**Climate** Gentle, with cool nights and foggy mornings.  
**Harvest** Hand picked. April, 2009.
