Tasting Notes This Pinot Noir is part Cono Sur Organic range, which wines have been made from grapes grown organically. It is appealing in its rich and deep bright red colour. Its complex and developed nose is governed by sweet wild fruit aromas, where notes of cherries and berries are enhanced by slight toasty hints. This Pinot definitely has a personality of its own. It's tasteful, with soft tannins and an excellent structure
