

ORGANIC SAUVIGNON BLANC 2009

Grape Sauvignon Blanc 100%
Appellation San Antonio Valley

Tasting Notes This Sauvignon Blanc made from grapes produced through an organic agriculture, come from the sandy, clayish soils of San Antonio Valley. It is a bright pale yellow wine that dazzles with its citrus notes and white flowers and melon, which mingle in with herbal hints. In mouth, its minerality and excellent balance especially stands out, along with its citric notes and a pleasant mineral ending. It is a great wine for chicken, seafood, spicy food and vegetables.

Vineyard Origin Leyda, Campo Lindo Estate 100%.
Soil Alluvial and gravelly. Low in fertility.
Climate Cool climate, very close to the coast (20km). Cool nights and foggy mornings. Gentle temperature during the day (26C°)
Harvest Hand picked, April 4th, 2009.
