Grape Pinot Noir 100%
Appellation Casablanca Valley

Tasting Notes This is a very expressive Pinot Noir from the Casablanca Valley. It is a deep ruby and purple red color that reflects its dark red fruit aromas such as ripe raspberries, cherries, and strawberries that combine with hints of coffee and cacao. It is fruity and full in the mouth with soft tannins that lead to a pleasant and lingering finish.

Soil Sandy with clay, low in water retention.
Climate Gentle, with cool nights and foggy mornings.
Harvest Hand picked. April, 2009.
