<b>Grape</b>	Carmenere / Cabernet Sauvignon / Syrah / Carignan / A. Bouchet 85 / 9 / 3 / 2 / 1%
<b>Appellation</b>	Cachapoal Valley
<b>Tasting Notes</b>	This Carmenere comes from the Colchagua Valley, notorious for producing excellent Carmenere because of its clay and stony soils and its sunny climate. These are what give this Visión Single Vineyard Carmenere its velvety tannins. Fruity, black cherry aromas combine beautifully with hints of coffee, bitter chocolate, leather and hazelnut. This is a firm-structured wine with ample, ripe tannins that give it a rich and supple texture.
