Tasting Notes This bright ruby red Pinot Noir from the Colchagua Valley is fresh, clean and aromatically intense. In the nose ripe raspberries, cherries, and strawberries combine beautifully with slight hints of coffee and cacao. This is an elegant Pinot Noir with a full and fruity palate and silky, soft tannins.

Vineyard Origin Santa Elisa Estate (100%), planted in 1968.
Soil Alluvial and gravelly. Low fertility.
Climate Template, warm during day and cold at night. Foggy mornings.
Harvest Hand picked, March, 2009.

Winery Viña Cono Sur. Santa Elisa Estate. Chimbarongo.
Ageing Process The wine spends 6 months in a 100% French, medium toasted oak. 1 month in stainless steel tanks.
