

## CONO SUR VISIÓN SINGLE VINEYARD PINOT NOIR 2010

**Vintage** 2010  
**Grape** Pinot Noir 100%  
**Appellation** Colchagua Valley

**Tasting Notes** This Pinot Noir from the San Antonio Valley is a deep ruby red and purple. It is aromatically intense, with ripe raspberry, cherry and strawberry aromas interlaced with hints of coffee and cacao. In the mouth it is fruity and full with silky, soft tannins.

**Vineyard Origin** Santa Elisa Estate (100%), planted in 1968.  
**Soil** Alluvial and gravelly. Low fertility.  
**Climate** Template, warm during day and cold at night. Foggy mornings.  
**Harvest** Hand picked. April, 2010.

**Ageing Process** 11 months in barrels
