

## CONO SUR VISIÓN SINGLE VINEYARD RIESLING 2011

**Vintage** 2011  
**Grape** Riesling 100%  
**Appellation** Bío Bío Valley

**Tasting Notes** This Riesling - with its bright, clear and yellow-green color - is unique as one of the southernmost wines in the world. Its sharp citrus aroma reflects the grapefruit, lemon and lime flavors while not overpowering the quince and white floral notes. In the mouth it is balanced and full. The grass and fruity notes are balanced by soft fruity flavors and its mineral complexity. This Riesling has a strong personality that makes for an elegant and juicy wine. Try it with seafood, white meats, and cheeses.

**Climate** Cold, rainy during spring and summer time.  
 Pluviometry 1.100 mm.  
**Harvest** Hand picked. April, 2011.
